(to all) A reading from the apostle Paul in Corinthians, chapter 13: Love is patient, love is kind

(to all) Friends, let us pray for this happy couple as they reaffirm their sacred marriage vows: Holy Father of Heaven and Earth, Thank you for the blessing of an amazing journey of ____ years together in marriage for ****spouse2**** and ****spouse1****.
